



Parking of RVs, Fifth Wheels and Other Trailers

RVs, Travel Trailers, or any other type of trailer must be parked on an improved surface (concrete, gravel or paved).

Recreation Equipment, Mobile (parking and storage)

Mobile recreation equipment may be parked or stored on developed residential property in compliance with applicable fire codes and no closer than ten (10) feet to any building on adjoining properties. Mobile recreation equipment shall not be parked or stored on a public street, alley or other public right-of-way or parkway. Mobile recreation equipment shall be placed at least fifteen (15) feet from the edge of all arterial streets and at least ten (10) feet the edge of all other streets.

Mobile recreation equipment shall not be used for sleeping, housekeeping or office space when parked or stored on property in an AO or residential zoning district or in any other location not approved for such a use, with the exception that not more than one (1) trailer, semi-trailer or self propelled motor vehicle owned by a nonresident visitor to Abilene that is designed, constructed and equipped for human habitation may be occupied by the said nonresident visitor and his family on a developed residential lot with the permission of the owner or person in control of such lot for not more than fourteen (14) days during any sixty (60) day period.
